Residential Summer Camp 2020

What is Summer Camp? Camp is a great opportunity to improve your riding and horse management skills. It offers an intensive opportunity to make real improvements, while having fun in great company!

When is it?

Summer Camp 1 - 28th July – 31st July 2020

Summer Camp 2 - 11th August – 14th August 2020

What age do I need to be to join Summer Camp? There is a minimum age of 10 years for Summer Camp. Please contact the office to discuss if your child is not quite 10 years old. We do offer a day camp for younger members, further details below.

What time do I need to be there? From 9-5pm. If you are bringing your own horse or pony you can arrive from 8.30am on the first day. On Thursday we have a BBQ, so please pick up at 7pm. On the last day (Friday) we have prize giving at 4pm, parents are very welcome to come along and join us for prize giving. If you need to arrive or depart outside of these times, please inform the office and we will do our best to accommodate your needs.

What will I be doing? You will be busy! Riding both morning and afternoon and taking responsibility for the care of your horse throughout camp. Ridden sessions will include a mixture of; flatwork, dressage, gymkhana games, TREC and hacking. Show Jumping & cross country are also included for those who are competent to do so. There will also be demonstrations and stable management sessions. The last day of Camp will be competition day.

What is Competition Day? On the last day there will be an opportunity to put to the test all you have learnt. There will be plenty of opportunity to win rosettes, trophies and prizes. We encourage parents and guardians to come along to prize giving at 4pm on the last day of Camp.

What level of riding experience do I need to have? Camp suits all levels of experience and ability. The program is planned to cater for everyone. Groups will be divided on rider experience.

What about lunch and refreshments? You can bring a packed lunch, or purchase lunch from Tumpy Teas. We recommend that you do not bring more than £5 each day to camp, this will be plenty to cover lunch. You can pre book lunch from Tumpy T's for the duration on camp.

What if I don't know anyone? No problem, one of the great things about camp is that it offers an opportunity to make new friends! There will be plenty of help on hand.

Can I choose the horse I will be riding? We try to pair people up with their choice of horse, however please be aware that we cannot guarantee your horse allocation.

How many children will be in each riding group? Riding groups are divided up according to ability. All children are assessed during their first ride on Tuesday morning and are put in to groups of usually no more than 8 riders. There are normally up to 5 riding groups per week.

Please, please, please don't read too much into the allocated group. Every camp the levels of the groups are different depending on bookings, for example a child happily jumping 2' 6" may find herself in "Pink" group one week, but on another week, might be in "Blue" group or even "Red". These colours are random every week. We may have two groups of similar ability.

For safety's sake if friends are of different riding levels, but they want to be in the same group, the better rider will need to move down to the group of the less experienced rider – we can only do this if that group has space. Even if 2 friends are in different riding groups, they will spend a lot of their time together during their days, i.e. until 10am, lunch time, and when the afternoon riding session finishes.

If I bring my own horse can it stay for Camp? Yes, we offer DIY livery for the duration of Camp, this is £10 per night. You will need to provide your own bedding, hay & hard feed. Limited grazing in small paddocks is possible by arrangement, subject to availability. Your horse can come the day before Camp if that makes it easier for you.

How much does Camp cost? £100 deposit secures a place, with the balance payable 4 weeks before the camp start date. £360 school horse / £305 own horse. There are discounts for siblings, please contact the office for full details. The camp is residential, campers will need to bring their own tent and sleeping bag etc. If you do not wish to stay overnight, please let us know at time of booking. There is a £50 reduction in the price of camp if you are not staying.

Do I stay overnight at Summer Camp? No, you do not have to stay, there is a £50 reduction in cost if you choose not to stay. If you are not staying please let us know at time of booking, so we can plan the evening activities. If you are staying you will need bring your own tent. For those camping overnight we provide breakfast and an evening meal. You can also purchase lunch directly from Tumpy T's, it is £20 for Summer Camp. Please hand in at the office in an envelope clearly marked Lynsey's –Summer Camp.

What will be do in the evenings? We work hard to create a friendly fun atmosphere at our Camp Campsite. Each evening we will coordinate fun games to ensure we all sleep well. So, whether it's a game of rounders, or show jumping on foot, there will be lots of fun. It is also possible to book additional private lessons in the evening if you want to get some extra practice in. Please check our website for prices.

What do I need to bring for Camp?

Please ensure all items are clearly marked, you will be responsible for all items.

- Riding hat – tested to British Safety Standard PAS 015 or equivalent – We do also have a selection of hats available from the office.
- Body Protector conforming to BETA standard (Compulsory if doing Cross Country, highly recommended for all other mounted activities)
- Jodhpurs or trousers suitable for riding. (Track suit bottoms are preferable to jeans)
- Riding boots. (These **must** have a clearly defined heel, **NOT** Wellingtons or trainers – or shoes with a wedge or flat sole)
- You might like to bring show gear for the last day, which is competition day, but don't worry this is optional.

- Wellies
- Wet weather clothing
- Gloves
- Shirt and Tie (for end of week 'Show Day' competition)
- Tumpy Green Sweatshirt and/or T-shirt
- Torch
- Notebook and pencil
- Grooming kit
- Tent
- Casual wear for evenings
- Trainers
- Toiletries – toothbrush, paste, flannel, face towel, bath towel, shampoo, hairbrush, hair ties
- Towel
- Sleeping bag, mat & pillow
- Plate, bowl, cup and cutlery



A phone will be available to campers, as mobiles are discouraged. Contact throughout the camps will be Renee / Naomi (01453 899002 / 07799610960).

Do I need pocket money? Pocket money is not required, you can leave money for snacks in an envelope, clearly marked – Lynsey's, Summer Camp and the name of your child. If you wish to buy any items of Tumpy Green clothing, this can be done direct via the supplier, the full range can be found in the clothing album on our Facebook page. All items can be personalised at no additional cost and postage is included in listed prices. To place your order, send an email to info@clippitycloponline.com. What if I need any medicine? Where appropriate, please provide in writing any information concerning medical conditions and medication currently being administered. Any pills or medicines must be handed to the Centre Manager on arrival together with precise details of administration. Please note we are unable to give medicine such as Calpol without written consent from the parent/guardians. If you feel your child may need to take medicine during their time with us please bring this with you for their holiday.

What happens if I leave something at the end of camp? Lost / left property will be placed in the lost property box, please collect as soon as possible. Please ensure **ALL ITEMS ARE CLEARLY MARKED WITH OWNER'S NAME**. We cannot be responsible for lost clothing or equipment. Mobile phones and computer games are not recommended as they are easily damaged or lost. Un-named lost property will be kept for one month, after which if not claimed it will be donated to a local charity.

What if my child is not 10 years and above, can they still get involved in Summer Camp? We do offer a Day Camp for younger riders, this is arranged on an individual basis, so please contact the office to discuss. There is limited availability for Day Camp, so please contact the office as early as possible to discuss. Day Camp £60 on own horse / £80 on school horse.

What happens if there is a cancellation? Tumpy Green reserves the right to cancel bookings for any reason beyond our control, in which case all monies paid will be refunded. If guests have to cancel, notice must be given in writing more than **six weeks** prior to the start date of the holiday, the deposit payment will be retained.

Refunds are not made. If you have to cancel within six weeks of the start date of camp, fees are due in full and no money will be returned. If you wish to change to another camp, notice must be given in writing at least six weeks before the start date of the holiday. We will endeavour to find and offer another available and acceptable date within the current year. If such alternatives cannot be accepted within the current year, all payments will be retained to defray costs of the cancellation. An administration fee of £15.00 will be charged for each change made. Failure to provide required notice in respect of cancellations or changes to camp will result in all monies being forfeited.

What happens if someone misbehaves? Living alongside and mixing with other children is a valuable part of the camp experience and we try to ensure that everyone is included. Every child wishes to enjoy their camp and we keep a close check on teasing, bullying or any other anti-social behaviour that may spoil an individual's enjoyment. Our experience over the years means this is rarely a problem, but please tell your children that they must speak to an Instructor or Supervisor if this should occur. If your child informs you of a problem, please contact the office so that we can take immediate steps to remedy the situation. When necessary, we will be firm with children who are affecting the enjoyment of others. If problem behaviour is persistent or serious we will contact the parent or guardian. We reserve the right to send any child home immediately at parent/guardians' expense and to charge for any costs incurred. **No refunds will be made for any children sent home for behavioural reasons.**



How do we book? Places cannot be held without a completed booking form AND a deposit of £100 per child, per week, or the full fees if less than 6 weeks to arrival date. All spaces are allocated on a 1st come 1st served basis. You can book in person in the office at Tumpy Green, over the phone or by sending a booking form. If the week becomes full before your form arrives, you will be notified and placed on a waiting list if requested.
