Class 3: Prelim 7 (2002) **Trailblazers Junior & Senior Qualifier** 20m x 40m arena

Class 4: Prelim 17A (2017) South West Hartpury Dressage Championships Qualifier

Cannot be ridden bitless, to be ridden under BD rules 20m x 60m arena

Class 5: Novice 39 (2010) South West Hartpury Dressage Championships Qualifier and Trailblazers Junior & Senior Qualifier

Cannot be ridden bitless, to be ridden under BD rules 20m x 60m arena

Class 6: Elementary 59 (2010) South West Hartpury Dressage Championships Qualifier and Trailblazers Senior Qualifier

ENTRY FEES:

All classes £13

Rosettes: to sixth place

CLOSING DATE: The Thursday before the competition. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held. Start Time: Class 1, will not start before 9.00

TIMES: start lists with times will be in the documents section of Equo Events, and Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of Friday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: class presentations will be un-mounted about 25 minutes after the end of the class by the Secretary area

HARTPURY QUALIFYING CLASSES: Combinations placed 1st and 2nd with a score of over 62% will be eligible to qualify.

Once qualified please register your details (Name, e-mail address, where qualified and which class qualified for) via e-mail to shows@hartpury.ac.uk **within 14 days of qualifying**. Further information and entry forms will be sent out nearer to the competition date.

Championship 1—Preliminary 17A Championship 2—Novice 39 Championship 3—Elementary 59 Entry fee £16 per Championship class. Rosettes to 10th place and prizes in kind. Entries close Friday 12th May.

Warm—up Classes - Class 1—Preliminary 15 Class 2—Novice 22 Class 3—Elementary 40 Entry fee £12 per warm-up class. Rosettes to 6th place.

Please note: 1. In the event that you have gained qualification in more than one different section you may take your place in a maximum of two of the Championship classes only. 2. Restrictions for horses that are or have been registered with British Dressage are as follows - Preliminary qualification: Not to have won any BD or BE points - Novice qualification: Not to have won more than 124 BD points - Elementary qualification: Not to have won more than 199 BD points 3. Winning combinations of championship classes in 2016 will not be eligible to compete in the same championship class in 2018.

Entries are only accepted on this basis. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

3. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Tumpy Green Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them. Please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

RULES AND NOTICES

1. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day).

2. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/ email the Entries Secretary for available spaces. A waiting list will be held if necessary.

3. Closing date for entries – Thursday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.) Refunds will be minus a £5 administration charge.

4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded on receipt of an s.a.e. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.

5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN – please see the documents section of Equo Events. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time – please be ready.

6. Warm-up Arena – the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the warm-up.

7. We don't use numbers so when you arrive, simply get ready and warm up.

8. Children must not ride in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.

9. Each horse/pony may only compete once in each class. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary via the Rider's DC and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition.

10. Turnout for ALL riders and horses is relaxed. Please contact the Entries Secretary BEFORE the show day for any queries re dress/turnout.
11. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
12. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
13. We sometimes get withdrawals so it really helps if you can be ready to ride your test approx. 10 mins before the time shown.
14. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.
15. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road.
16. **All classes are run under British Dressage rules.**
17. The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor behaving in such a manner as to breach these rules.
18. Plaiting is optional
19. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or alter the order of classes if there are insufficient entries.
20. Requests with regards to times can be declared in your entry notes and the organisers will do their best to accommodate these.
21. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
